Inventory your systems

List every system that touches back-of-house operations, and who actually owns each one

Run the two-question seam test

For any two systems that describe the same shift, location, or event, ask both questions below

Q1

Does someone manually reconcile data between these two systems more than once a month?

Yes to both

→ **Close it.** This seam is a standing tax.

Q2

Would a delayed or wrong answer here create food-safety, compliance, or brand-standard risk?

Yes to one

→ **Monitor it.** Revisit next quarter.

Set your priority order

Close the seams that touch food safety or brand standards first; leave the cheap ones alone

Close first

Close next
