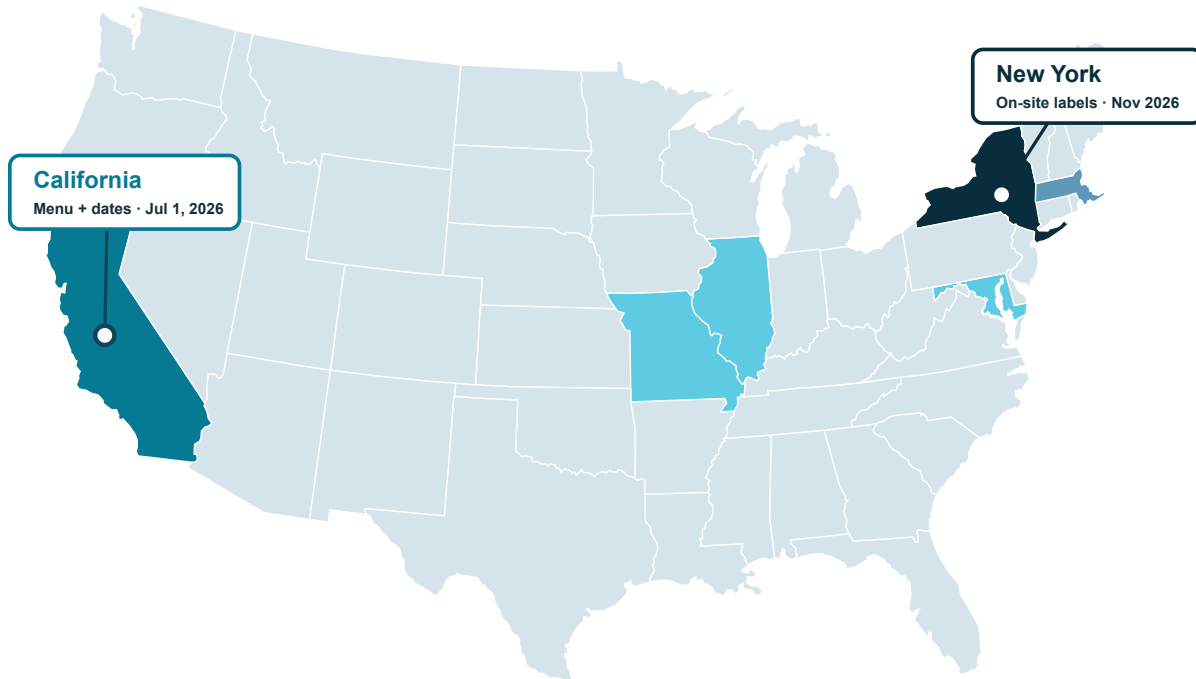


Multi-State Food Labeling Compliance Map

NEW YORK · S5381A / A6558A

On-Site Allergen Labeling

Written allergen notification on food prepared & packed on-site. Covers restaurants, delis, **grocery, c-stores — all sizes.**

● Effective November 2026

CALIFORNIA · SB 68 (ADDE ACT)

Menu Allergen Disclosure

Disclose the 9 major allergens per menu item. Applies to large restaurants with 20+ **locations.**

● Effective July 1, 2026

CALIFORNIA · AB 660

Standardized Date Labels

Standardizes “use by” (safety) and “best if used by” (quality); bans “sell by.” **Coded dates still OK.**

● Effective July 1, 2026

The 9 Major Allergens to Flag
